Who are we?

The Coventry & Warwickshire Sign Language Interpreting Service is an independent interpreting agency.

We provide a high quality service. We only use NRCPD registered interpreters. This means they:

- are professionally trained
- hold a current CRB check
- carry Professional Indemnity Insurance

Our professional Sign Language interpreters have to follow a code of practice which ensures confidentiality.

Sign Language interpreters will interpret to the best of their ability and will remain impartial.

What do we do?

We provide a service so that both deaf and hearing people can communicate easily and fully.

We will book interpreters for any occasion in the Coventry and Warwickshire area.

When we have booked an interpreter(s) we will confirm in writing or by phone.

For further information you can contact us by phone, fax or email.

There may be a charge to your organisation. If you are not sure then please ask.

What you need to do

As interpreters are in short supply it is best to book as early as possible.

When you contact us to request an interpreter we will need to know:

- Date
- Time
- Duration of event
- Venue
- Type of event

We may ask you to send us some information about the event so the interpreter can prepare in advance. If you are having an open event and are not sure if deaf people will be attending it is always best to book an interpreter.
